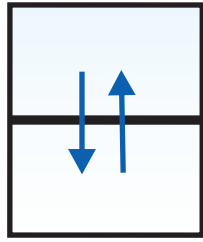


HOW MANY WINDOWS DO I HAVE?

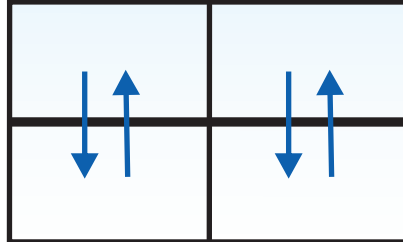
This is a quick break down of how we count windows and what is considered a pane of glass.

Slides up and down



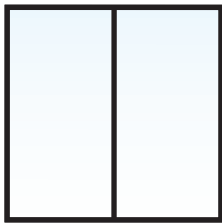

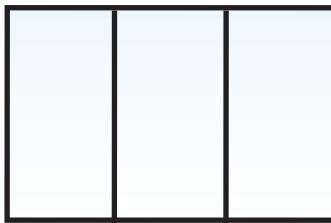

CASEMENT

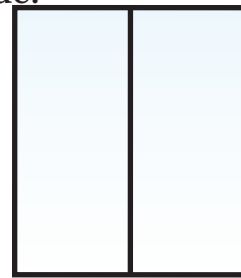
These usually crank out to the left or the right.
If there is a screen, it is on the inside.



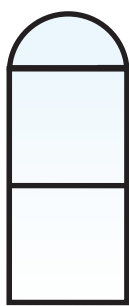

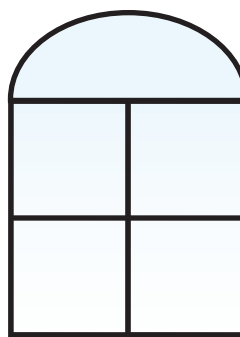

TRUE DIVIDED LIGHT WINDOWS & DOORS

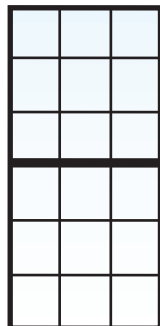
Windows with multiple individual panes of glass (see examples below)



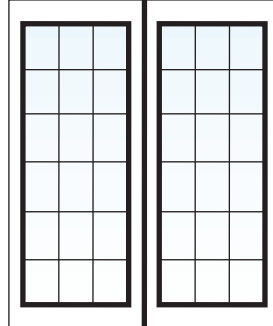
6/6 = 12 panes



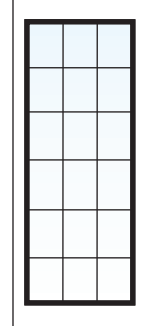
8/8 = 16 panes

36 panes

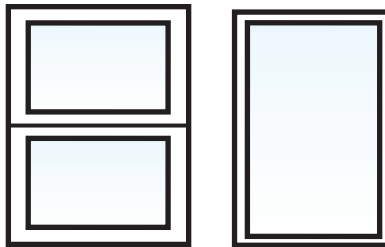

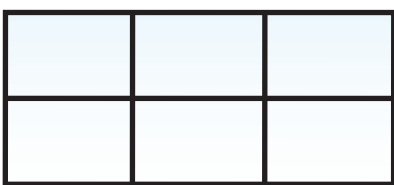
STORM WINDOWS

Type 1: Four separate panes of glass and a screen covering half of the window

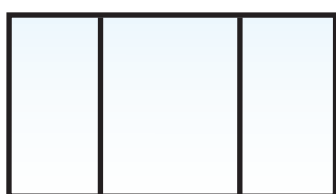
Type 2: A Secondary window attached over a normal window



MISCELLANEOUS WINDOWS, DOORS, SLIDING GLASS DOORS



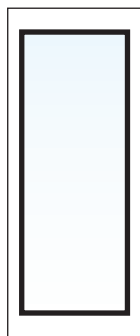

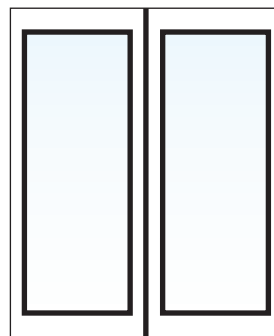

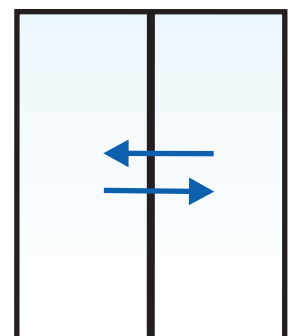
